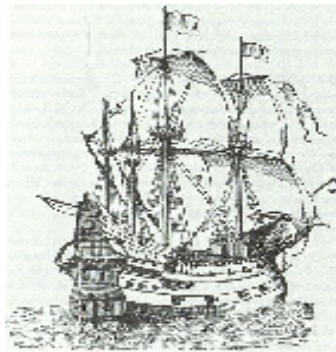
What Charity Will You Vote For?
